Bicycle Categories

1. Singles:

Bicycles sold as singles will generally be high end, name brands including, but not limited to, the following: Trek, Specialized, Giant, Santa Cruz, Orbea, KHS, Jamis, Yeti, GT and Pinarello.

Examples of typical singles:

- Clean condition with no major damage
- High end and/or name brand models with missing parts
 - For example, a Pinarello with missing wheels will qualify as a single bicycle because the frame is worth thousands of dollars
- Some vintage bicycles depending on brand and condition

2. Bulk Lots:

Bicycles sold as bulk lots will generally be low end, department store brands including, but not limited to, the following: Next, Magna, Mongoose, Huffy, Roadmaster, Quest and Pacific.

Examples of typical bulk lots:

- Department store bicycles in excellent to poor condition
- All other bicycles that do not fit the "Single" or "Disposal" profile

3. Disposal:

Bicycles subject to disposal will generally be:

- Damaged beyond reasonable repair
- Have bent or broken frames
- Manufacturer recalled
